It appears from the records here that two warrants, relating to this property, have been issued and executed as follows viz:-

1st Warrant issued August 28th 1858 to Ferdinand F. Gross for one hundred acres of the bed of the Allegheny River, which tract seems to include the land in question.

2nd Warrant issued to John Dunn and William J. Poor March 16th 1868 for a tract of land, a small portion of which seems to be included in this tract.

A Draft of a tract of land situated in the ^{City} ~~Township~~ of Pittsburg and County of Allegheny, containing Five and Thirty-one hundredths (5.31) acres/ ~~perches and allowance of six per cent for road~~. Surveyed the seventeenth day of May 1898, in pursuance of a warrant granted to William F. Aull dated the thirteenth day of April 1898.
