Being part of a larger Tract of 268^{ac} and allorance which was Originally Surveyed by William Matthews late D.S. on the 2^d day of the 4th Mo. 1770. for Stephen McKinly in pursuance of two Warrants, one granted to Richard McDonnell for 100^{ac} dated the 22^d day of March 1743, the other granted to David McKinly for 50^{ac} dated the 1st day of April 1751. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger Tract of Land At the instance of Thomas McKinly the present owner on the 2^d day of April 1821.
