



Situate in Dover Township in the County of York, containing as above set forth 179° & 12 perches & allowance &c. being part of a larger tract of 375° & 111 perches and allowance of six per cent &c. originally surveyed by George Stevenson late D.D. on the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of April A.D. 1754. In pursuance of a Warrant for 200<sup>0</sup> granted to Jeremiah Dungan bearing date the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of December A.D. 1753. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract of land on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of July A.D. 1800. by John Eichelberger late D.D. and now at the request of the owner David Wolkenuth the above has been calculated examined and found to be correct the 20<sup>th</sup> day of August 1811, and at his request returned for Confirmation
