



Situate in Dover Township, York County containing as above set forth thirty nine acres, seventy eight perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c. Being part of a larger tract of 277 1/2 acres & allowance originally surveyed by John Forsyth Esq. late D.S. for the representatives of Jacob Moyer, on the 2nd day of February A.D. 1790 - in pursuance of a warrant granted to the said Jacob Moyer for ^{land} dated the 10th day of July A.D. 1762 - The above part resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract on the 10th day of March A.D. 1806, and now at the request of Jacob Kochnower, the present owner of said part the Draught is examined, corrected, and returned for confirmation - January 14th 1822.
