land in Said Survey is the same land which was Sold and Conveyed as the  
property of Lewis Fluck deceased by George W. Baker <sup>as</sup> Sheriff of Bedford County  
to John Tod Eqr. in trust for <sup>said</sup> James Entreken Eqr. by Deed Pole dated the 10th. Day  
of November A.D. 1821 and Duly acknowledged in and before the Court of Common  
Pleas of Bedford County by Said Sheriff on Said 10th. Nov. 1821 Sworn and Sub-  
scribed before me this 16th. of May 1843.
