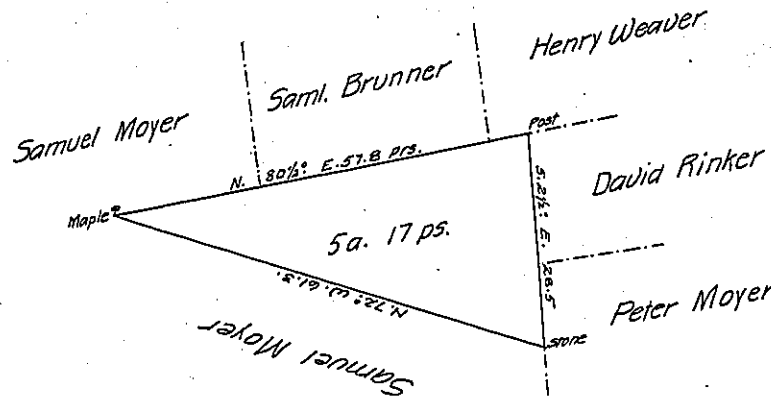


I do hereby certify that the above is a true copy of an original Draught of a Tract of Land in Springfield Township Bucks County Surveyed to Casamer Hempt on the 5th. day of Sept. 1800 by Isaac Hicks Dep. Surveyor by virtue of a Warrant dated the 7th. day of November 1797 which Draught is made on the back of the said Warrant by the said Isaac Hicks And is now on file in my Office.

And I do hereby certify that the said Lot of Land has been resurveyed by me on the 22nd. day of June 1843 and contains as per Draught 5 acres & 17 perches.



I do also certify that the said Casamer Hempt has recently Deceased and the said Lot was sold by Daniel Applebach his Administrator by virtue of an order of the Orphans Court of Bucks County to David Rinker of Springfield Township aforesaid to whom the Patent is desired to issue.

When the Patent is made out send it to me with a Bill of the fees & expences and I will remit the same to you.
