Containing 201 Acres & 110 perches and allowance Part A containing 94 acres & 28 perches and allowance, was originally surveyed May 5-1793, in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Anthony Howard, dated January 11th 1793 — Part B containing 40 acres & 133 perches and allowance, is part of a larger tract originally surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant granted to said Anthony Howard dated May 8th 1794 — Part C containing 66 acres & 109 perches and allowance was originally surveyed February 4th 1767, in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Samuel Flower dated January 5th 1750. Now September 29th 1864, re-surveyed for the use of Samuel Berg, present owner
