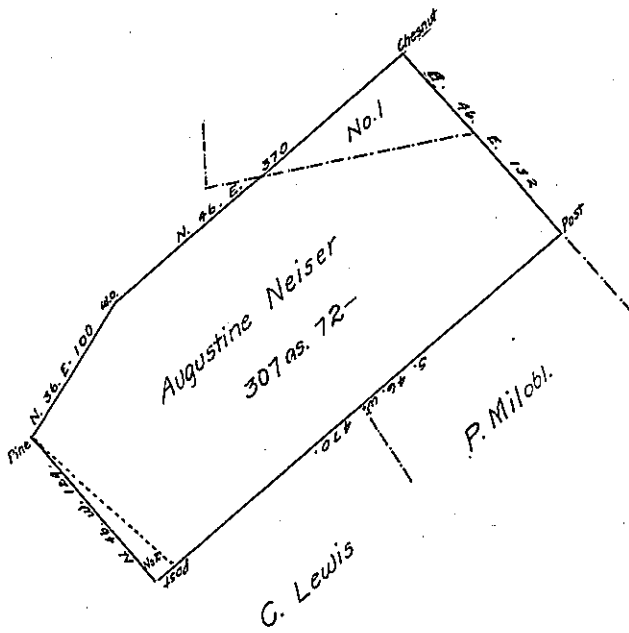

Situate on the waters of Little Juniatta in Antis Township Huntingdon County Containing Three Hundred and Seven acres and Seventy two perches and allowance of Six per Cent — Surveyed for Augustine Neiser on order No. 3024 dated the 9th day of March 1767. No. 1 represents part of the draught of a survey made for James Greige on Warrant dated the 17th day of April 1795. This Survey interferes twenty seven acres and Seventy perches with the Augustine Neiser Survey — James Greige conveyed to David McMurtrie and James McMurtrie the present owners — No. 2 represented by a dotted line is part of a survey made for Robert Robison on order No. 1636 dated the 22d. October 1766 This Survey interferes Six acres with the Augustine Neiser Survey — Robert Robison conveyed to John Patton Esqr the present owner — John Hunter Improved part of the Augustine Neiser tract and sold his improvement to Glaninger & Co who had purchased the Augustine Neiser tract for taxes and are the present owners — John Bradley Improved part of the Augustine Neiser tract about 20 years ago and holds part of said tract by his Improvement without Survey.
