



Situate on both sides of Stoney Creek in Stoney Creek Township Somerset County, and Surveyed the 19th day of January 1802 (in part which part was lately returned to the Surveyor General, with intent to be patented, to itself; I have since Viz the 30th day of July 1813 Surveyed the the remainder, the parties Concerned now with the Patent to issue for the whole to Christian Royer in Right of Christian Levingston) In pursuance of a Warrant Granted to Christian Levingston for 400a. dated the 12th day of August 1799 NB. This Survey includes Levingstons Old Oil Mill upon Stony Creek, and it appears to have been first Improved the first day of March 1797- there is about 30 Acres of Land Cleared — upon this tract and it is now dwelt upon by Christian Royer with his family.
