



Situated on the Waters of Redstone Creek on the North side of the road leading from Thomas Gist's to Redstone old Fort in Franklin Township Fayette County and Surveyed the 11th Day of November 1785- In pursuance of a Certificate Issued by the Commissioners appointed by the State of Virginia &c. - of which the following is a true Copy - We the Commissioners appointed for adjusting the Claims to unpatented lands in the Counties of Monongalia Yohogania and Ohio do hereby Certify that Robert McLaughlin is entitled to Three hundred acres of land in the County of Yohogania on the waters of Redstone Creek to include his Settlement made in the Year of our Lord One thousand seven Hundred and sixty Seven - Given under our hands at Redstone old Fort the Third day of December 1779 in the fourth Year of the Commonwealth.
