Benjamin Mc Cormick, Ass<sup>ts</sup> Thomas Russel produced a Certificate from the Com<sup>rs</sup> appointed to adjust Claims and grant Unpatented lands, in the Counties of Yohogania, Monongahela & Ohio, In these words "We the Commissioners for adjusting Claims and granting Unpatented Lands in the Counties of Yohogania: Monongahela: & Ohio do hereby Certify that Benjamin Mc Cormick Assignee, Thomas Russel is entitled to four hundred acres of land in the County of Yohogania on Muntoors Run to include his Improvement made in the year 1774 - Given Under our hands at Coxs. Fort: the 8th Day March 1780, in the fourth year of the Commonwealth:
