Allowance. The Above Described Tract of Land between A and B was Surveyed to George Hain  
Junier By warrant Dated the 1<sup>st</sup> Day of March Ann Domini 1742-3 Containing Seventy One acres  
Beside y<sup>e</sup> Usual Allowance &c y<sup>e</sup> 30<sup>th</sup> Day of September A.D. 1743.
