



The above figure or Draught was survey'd at the especial order of Rees Thomas, Junier, Attorney for William Anberah and XXX in the year 1723 beginning at a certain white oak marked standing upon the North side of Taipatockin Creek on the West side of Scootrel River in the County of Chester and by the several courses and distance from the said white oak as it is laid down upon the said Draught by the account received from the Chain men does contain 7510 acres errors except'd, by mee

This twenty ninth day of October in ye year of our Lord 1731. David Powell.
