


**FORM No. 3.**



The above tract is an Interference of two several tracts. Part A was surveyed on Warrt to James Murphy dated Novemr 28th, 1747. Containing 162 as. 42 ps & a little. Part B was surveyed on Warrt to James Murphy dated Feby 11th, 1746. Containing 220  $\frac{3}{4}$  as & a little. All situate in Huntington Township. Part A is now owned by Nicholas Wierman. Part B by Andrew Hartman and Heirs of David Dermaree and part C by John Collins. Witness my hand —
