



In pursuance of a Warrant dated the 13th day of October, 1760, I have by Order of the Surveyor General dated the 26th day of December, 1760, Surveyed to the Honorable the Proprietaries a certain Island in the River Schuylkill, in the Province of Pennsylvania, between the Counties of Philadelphia & Chester about half a mile above the Mouth of Perkiomny Creek, opposite on the North Side to land of Richard Jacobs, and on the South Side to land of Andrew Holston.
