By the line trees it appears that the original survey for Nicholas Mint Warrt. was made at different times the line trees along Ulrich Mayers Survey count up to the year 1752 the line trees of the other lines bear different dates one survey seems to go around the tract & counts to the year or about between 1763 or 1764 This survey is also covered by an other warrant granted to Corneobl Klingerman dated the 14th of Sept. 1801 which is surveyed returned & patented and differs from Ns Mints survey & the dotted lines shew the courses & distances for Ns Mints survey are stated inside of the draught, those for Cornelius Klingermans Warrt. outside

The yellow part outside of the red survey contains 4 ac. 11 1/2 p. & allow, and the small little strip inside the red lines contains 4.1 p. & allow. Actual Suvey
