Draft of a tract of Land situate on the Waters of Lackawaxin and Equinunk Creeks in the County of Wayne, containing five thousand two hundred and fourteen acres, and one hundred and thirty nine perches, with the usual allowance of Six Per Centum for Roads, and resurveyed according to the old metes and bounds the twenty third, twenty fourth and twenty fifth days of August, one thousand eight hundred and four, for Peter Gastrell and others, in pursuance of an Order of the Board of Property, dated the seventh day of August, 1804.
