

Whereas the Commissioners of Property by their warrant dated the 30<sup>th</sup> day of July 1712 Granted to Isaac Norris Esq<sup>r</sup> Ten acres of Liberty land in right of Will<sup>m</sup> Lovel and by their warrant dated the 25<sup>th</sup> day of the first month 1715 Required me to survey to John Falconar and Andrew Hamilton sixty acres of land in the Liberties of Philadelphia which right of sixty acres was conveyed by Andrew Hamilton and Gilbert Falconar brother and Attorney to the said John Falconar among other lands to the said Isaac Norris by Deeds dated the 22<sup>d</sup> & 23<sup>d</sup> days of April 1715 And whereas the said Commissioners by their further warrant dated the sixteenth day of Janu<sup>y</sup> in the year 1726 Granted to the said Isaac Norris thirty acres of Liberty land in right of Charles Marshal Jonath Smith & Company And the said ~~Commissioners~~ Commiss<sup>rs</sup> having also by their warrant dated the 10 day of January in the year 1721 Granted to John Davies twenty acres of Liberties land in right of William Keris purchase of 125 acres the right \_\_\_\_\_
