



John Hood a part of the Swansons land on Scholkill viz Beginning at corner marked black oke tree standing by the Schol-kill in the Road at the fording place. Thence east south east by the land of John Calloes Three hundred ninty five perches to a corner marked post. Thence south sixty two degrees westerly by a line of marked trees dividing this from the land of the proprieto^{rs} Manro^s of Springets Berrey Two hundred and twelve perches to a spanish oke marked for a corner. Thence north north west halfe a point westerly Two hundred and eleven perches by overpluss^d land betwixt this and John Myflins unto a post for a corner Thence west by sd overpluss and Tho Shroots land one hundred and twenty perches to a post on Scholkill Thence by Scholkill up the Courses therof unto the place of Beginning. Containing two hundred acres of land.
