



Upon considering this Draught and comparing it with the Measures I formerly made at and about the old Bridge over the Run near Nathaniel Pooles, I do hereby certify that the Water Course of the said Run passed there before the Building of the New Bridge in Front Street continued to the Northward of the said New Bridge according as it is laid down on this Draught being about thirty four feet to the Northward of the place where it now passeth under the said New Bridge

B. the distance (on the East side of Front Street continued) between where the said Run passed before the (obliterated) When (obliterated) passes being 34 feet so that the courses of the Water is made to Run more to the South by 34 feet than it did before the Building of the said New Bridge
