Situate on the North Valley Mountain in the Township of Trediffryn in the County of Chester and Surveyed for the use of the said Proprietaries the 26th day of the 2nd mo 1765 and whereas by virtue of an order of the Board of Property dated the 26th day of May 1766 the Lines of the Lands of James Davis John Maxwell David Jones and Francis Allison was Continued up to the Welsh Line Whereby the same Land is divided into the aforesaid Lots and Contains Severally as is therein Expressed and is now returned in pursuance thereof in order for Confirmation - Certified and Surveyed this 29th day of December 1766
