Report The above tract appears to have been survey'd 2d May, 1806 & Patented as part of 370 acres held under a Warrant to John Fannells or Reynolds dated 6th October, 1738. Note the above dotted figure A appears to have ^{been} patent ed on Warrant to John Fannells dated 6 Oct' 1738, & on a Warr't to Patrick Jacht dated 20 Feb'y, 1754 and there fore the above 180 acres appears to have been patented on the same Warrant to John Reynolds of 1738 ^{a part of} as the larger tract represented by the dotted lines & marked A.

Note No evidence of Deniston Warr't having been executed on the land yet the above suits the location of said warrant J. Fannells Pat'd P. Jachts Pat'd Henry Strochr & David Bender owners & occupiers W. S. D.
