



Situate in Franklin township in the County of York containing, as above, set forth 10<sup>ac</sup> & 121 Perches, and Allowance &c. Being part of a larger tract, of 237<sup>ac</sup> & 19 Perches, and Allowance &c. which was Originally surveyed by Charles Lukens late D.S. In pursuance of a Warrant Granted to Robert Niel bearing date the 28<sup>th</sup> day of October A.D. 1757. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract, of Land on the 13<sup>th</sup> & 14<sup>th</sup> days of December 1814, at the request of the present owner Laurence Hykes, who desires the same to be returned for Confirmation the Sixteenth day of January A.D. 1815.
