



By Virtue of a Warrant, dated the 24<sup>th</sup> May 1809 Surveyed the 20<sup>th</sup> September 1814 to John Arnold the above described tract of Land situate in Chesnut hill township Northampton County containing forty Acres three quarters, and the allowance of Six Cent & 6<sup>th</sup>. The above land was first improved by Perry Gilmore in the year 1808 who lived with his family on the land, and raised grain thereon & sold his Right to the improvement to the above named John Arnold who had a family on the land for some time, but no family lived on the land when the Survey was made
