



Situate Formerly in Manahan township but now in Franklin Washington and Warrington townships in the County of York containing within the black lines, as above set forth 72^{2/3} & 76 Perches and Allowance. Being part of a larger tract of 74^{as} & 31^{Ps} and allowance which was Originally Surveyed by John Forsyth late D.S. on the 9th day of December 1784 for Jacob Baughman in pursuance of a Warrant for 50^{as} granted to Michael Aman bearing date the 29th day of January A.D. 1763. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract of Land the 8th & 9th days of December A.D. 1819 for Peter Wolgemuth the present owner who desired the same to be returned for confirmation.
