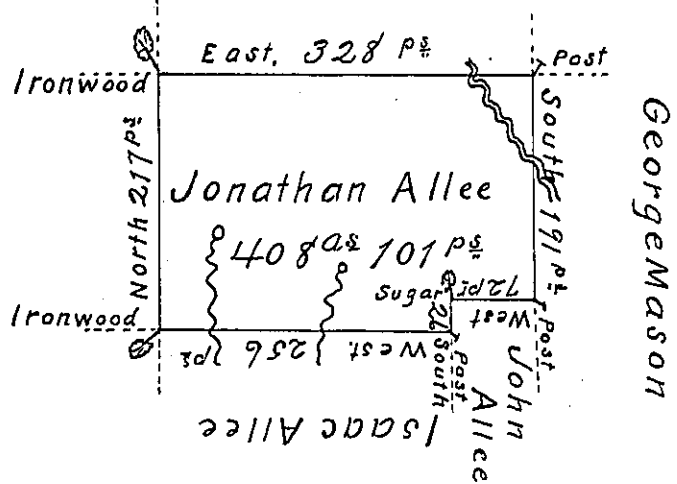


Jacob Hites



In pursuance of a Warrant, for 400 acres of land, dated the 6th day of August, 1814 was surveyed the November, the 10th 1814 for Jonathan Allee the above described Tract, of land containing four hundred eight Acres, one hundred and one perches, and allowance of Six per. Cent. for Roads &c Situate in Venango Township in the County of Crawford and at the time of Making the survey, the said Jonathan Allee family was actually living on the land, and there appeared that there was cleared fenced, and in a state of cultivation upwards of twenty Acres of the same—
