



Situate in Manallen Township Adams County Surveyed October 6th 1814 In pursuance of a warrant granted to Robert Alexander for 40^{ac} dated September 23rd 1814 Containing forty six acres one hundred & two perches & alle this is part of a tract which was improved in early times probably between 1740 & 1750 (the warrant to Thomas Berwick adjoining it was ~~dated~~ ^{dated} 1743) the tract has been divided into 3 farms the above being part of the middle one the residue of which lies in the manor of Opossum Creek part of the land contained in the ^{above} survey may from its appearance have been cleared fifty years Henry Walter the witness in the Certificate informed me that he was made to believe by the applicant that the above part included none of the plantation but the woodland and a small piece of new land
