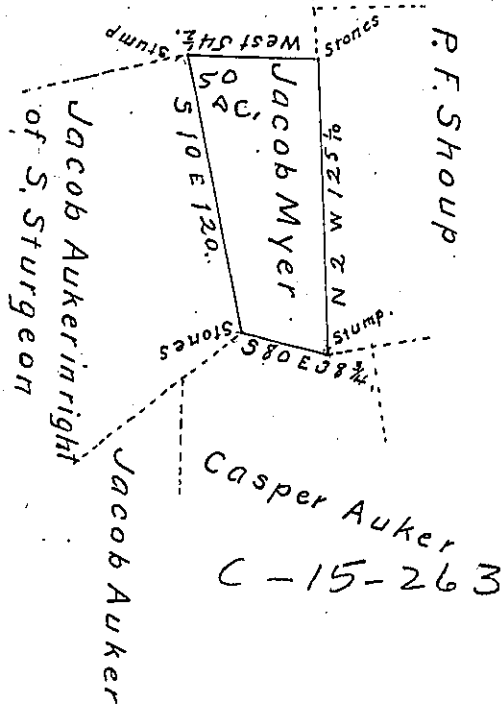


John McClelland



A Draught of thirty two acres and one hundred and forty nine perches of land with six per Cent for roads, situate in Greenwood township in Mifflin county which appears by Official papers remaining in the Deputy Surveyors Office in Mifflin town in and for said county, to have been surveyed 3<sup>d</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> December 1792 in pursuance of a Warrant to Jacob Myer for 50<sup>a</sup> dated 17<sup>th</sup> April 1775 - Examined 28<sup>th</sup> January 1811.

And, an Order of the Board, dated 5<sup>th</sup> Novem<sup>r</sup> 1792.
