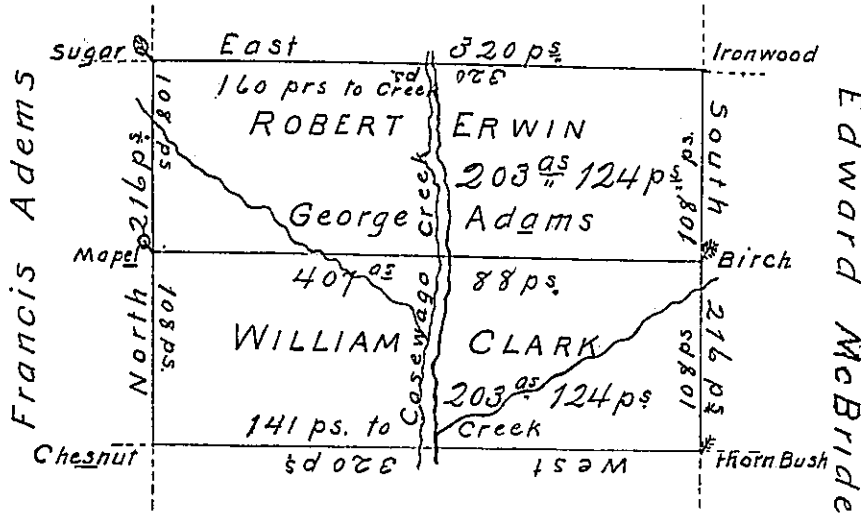


John Adams



CHRISTIAN LEMON

In pursuance of a Warrant for 400 acres, dated the 10th day of April A.D. 1793 was surveyed the 2d day of June A.D. 1817 for George Adams the above described tract of Land containing 407 acres = 88 perches and allowance of six per cent for Roads &c. and that the same was divided, as above stated (by Consent) Between William Clark the Assignee of the said George Adams, and Robert Erwin, and at the time of Making said survey the said Robert Erwin, was in the actual Resident possession of of the same, and had upwards of twenty acres of the Land cleared fenced, and in a good state of Cultivation a Dwelling house & other buildings situate in Casewago township Crawford County Pa.
