Containing Three hundred, and seven Acres, and One hundred, and one perches, and allowance of Six Cent for Roads, No 1 Containing Two hundred, and forty seven Acres, and thirty six perches & all. Being part of a tract of 321^{ac} 21^{ps} & all. Surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant Granted John Blair for 200^{ac} Dated the 8th day of September 1755. Nos 2 & 3. Containing Sixty Acres, and Sixty five perches & all. Being parts of a tract of 170^{ac} 18^{ps} Surveyed in pursuance of Warrant Granted William Allison for 150^{ac} Dated the 4th day of June 1762. Resurveyed, and laid off the above parts for Anthony Clippinger the 19th and 20th of May 1818.
