

James Brownlee

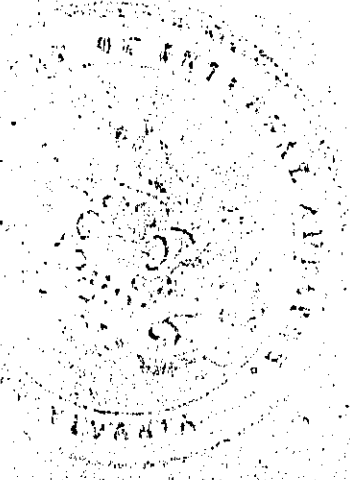
The above is a draught of a survey made the 7th of March 1816, in pursuance of a warrant granted to James Brownlee, dated the 13th of February 1816, Situate in Canton township in Washington county. Containing Three acres and eighteen perches and the usual allowance.

The above piece of land is nearly all cleared and under fence; it was first improved about the year 1782. Brownlee has had it in possession ever since. No opposing claims.
