



In pursuance of a Warrant for 400 acres, dated the 14th day of April, 1792, granted to John Adlums, was Surveyed on the Nineteenth day of November, 1830, the above described tract of land, containing 401 acres and 150 perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c. Situate in Sadsburg township in Crawford county (It being the same tract of land which was surveyed on the 28th day of October, 1794 in the name of John Barton in pursuance of his alleged improvement dated the 27th day of October, 1794.)
