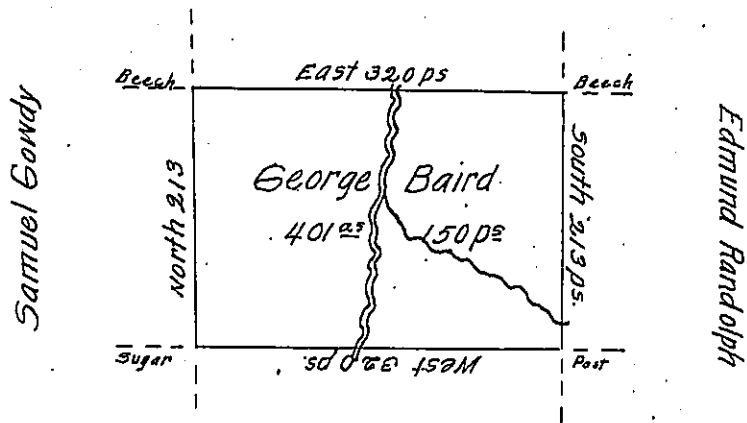

Surveyed the 5<sup>th</sup> day of March 1800, in pursuance of a warrant of 400 acres granted to George Baird bearing date the 4<sup>th</sup> day of January 1794.
