



In Pursuance of a Warrant to me Deicted to Survey unto William Green one Hundred and Sixty Seven Acres and one Quarter of an Acre no more (By Virtue of that Warrant Bearing Date the twenty Sixth day of January Anno Domi 1763 (<sup>granted</sup> ~~granted~~ to Thomas Gorden) I have Survey'd unto William Green in the township of Maxa towny in the County of Berks Adjoining the Land of Abraham Zemmerman and other the Quantity of one Hundred and Twenty Six Acres and 144 perches and the Allowance of Six p. Cent.
