



A draught of a tract of land situate in Macungie Barrens surveyed to Frederick Rabenholtz the 10th day of May 1771 by virtue of an order ~~the~~ from the Surveyor General containing one hundred and eleven Acres and twenty perches besides the usual Allowance of six per Cent for which the said Rabenholtz is to agree with the proprietary Agents taken from the Field-works of James Scull deceased.
