


Surveyed on the Fourteenth day of March 1733 to Ulrick Boidler a Tract of land Situate on the Branch of Perkiomie - Near New-cowissohoppin in the County of Philad^a. Begining at a Corner post of Humphrey Hills land thence by part of the Mannour of John Penn Esq^r South Forty Degrees West Two hundred & Nineteen perches to a Corner post of Henry Stovers land thence by the Same North West one hundred and Eighty perches to a post thence by land of Jacob Stover and other land of ye s.^d Ulrick Boidler North East Two Hundred and Seven perches to a post in the line of the s.^d Humphrey Hills Land thence by the Same South fifty Degrees East one hundred & Sixty perches to ye place of Begining. Containing Two hundred & thirteen Acres with Usual Allowance.
