


SAMUEL AND ROBERT PURVIAANCE



A Draught of a Survey called "Gabaroose" situate on the Waters of Cross Creek in Washington County, containing 400 Acres strict Measure surveyed on the 7<sup>th</sup> of March 1789 in Pursu<sup>ce</sup> of a Certif<sup>t</sup> for 400 Ac<sup>s</sup> granted to James Coleman by the Commiss<sup>r</sup>s appointed by Virg<sup>a</sup> to adjust the Titles of unpatented lands in the Counties Monong<sup>a</sup> Yonig<sup>a</sup> & Ohio which Certif<sup>t</sup> was duly entered with County Sur<sup>r</sup> as appears from the authenticated List dated 20 Decr 1779.
