In Pursuance of a warrant for 400 acres dated the twenty first day of April
A.D. 1794 granted to John Greble was surveyed on the Fourth day of November A.D. 1817. The above described tract of land containing 424 acres
84 perches and allowance of six percent for roads, &c. situated in Cas-
& part in Erie County
Senago township, Crawford county, and at the time of making the same,
Dominick McGride was residing thereon, and there was built a house fit for
the habitation of man, and there appeared to be upwards of twenty acres of
the land cleared, fenced and in a state of cultivation, and that the same was
divided as above stated, between
