



In Pursuance of a Warrant for 400 Acres dated the 21th day of April A.D. 1794 was surveyed for Henry Grassey, the 30th day of January, 1817 the above described tract of Land containing 413 acres 74 perches, and allowance of six per cent for Roads & C. and that, the same was divided as above stated Between Jedediah Freeman and Joseph Clark. and at the time of making said survey the said Jedediah Freeman was in Possession of the same and he had a house fit for the habitation of man and there appered, to be upwards of 10 acres of the land Cleared & fenced and that the same is situate in Venango Township Crawford County Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
