Surveyed on the 11th day of August Anno Domini 1814. In Pursuance of a Warrant for 15<sup>0</sup> Granted to Robert Gemmill bearing date the 6th day of July A. D. 1814.

N.B. The Improvements on the above described tract of Land at the time of Surveying were some cleared Land without any building thereon, and that made prior to the 28<sup>th</sup> day of March Anno Domini 1814.
