



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietary bearing date the 16th day of September anno Domini 1735, Decreeed on the 16th day of March anno Domini 1735/6 to the historical Hacres of Tract of Land in the Township of Hempfield & County of Lancaster Beginning at a Hickory or Corner of Isaac Morris's Land. Hence South East by South 285 per to a Hickory, Hence North East by East 104 per to a Black Oak, Hence North West by North 86 per to a post. Hence North East by East 20 per to a Black Oak, Hence North West by North 136 per to a White Oak. Hence North East by East 23 per to a Black Oak. Hence North West by North 51 per to a Black Oak. Hence South 85 deg. West 140 per to an Ash. Hence South 10 deg. East 60 per to the place of Beginning, containing Two hundred twenty six acres & $\frac{1}{2}$ with the usual allowance of six acres for Gentry Roads &c.
