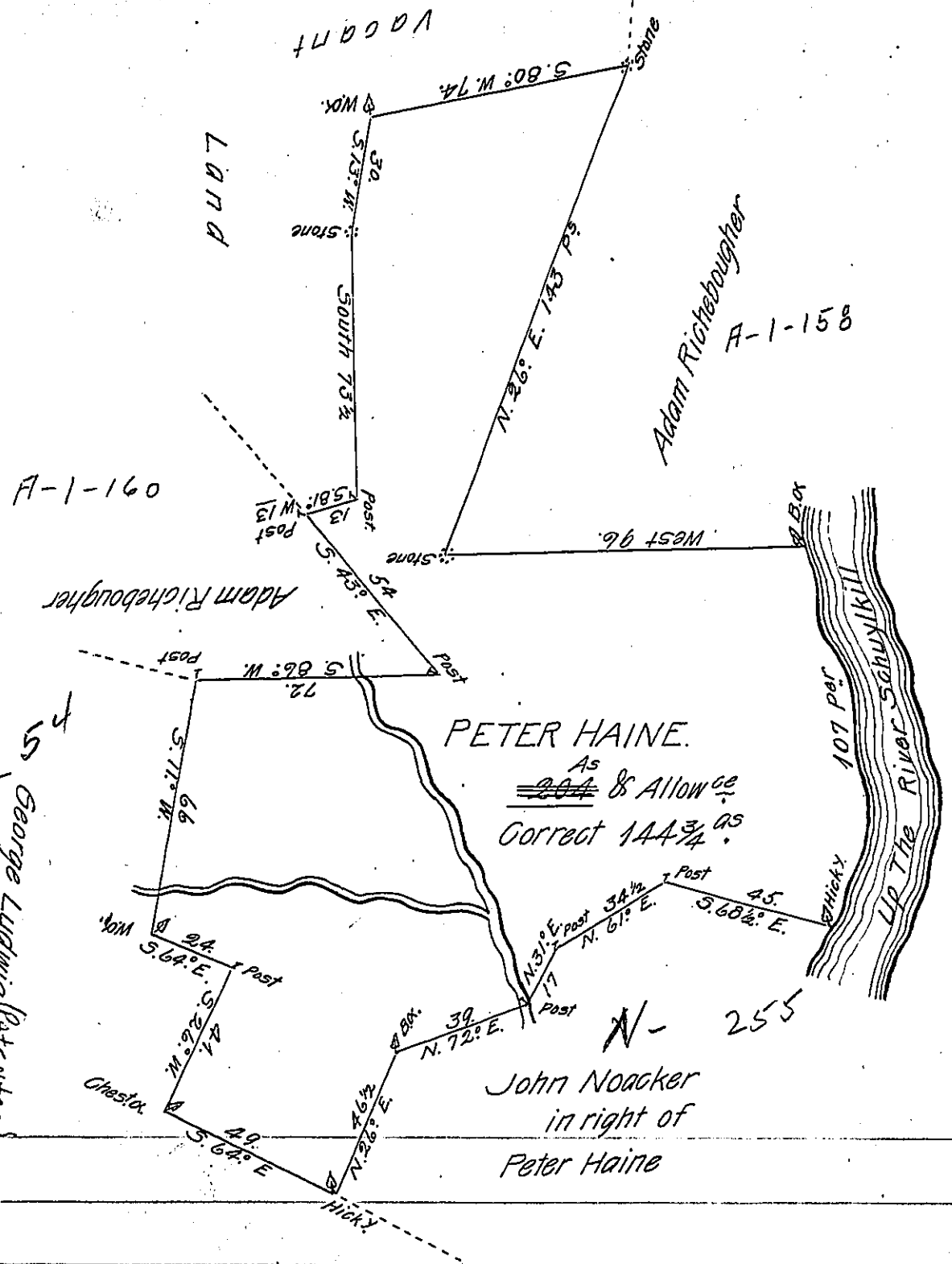


Note 144-^{AS} is part of 194-^{AS} surveyed in pursu-
