



A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate in Milford Township (formerly Cumberland) now Mifflin County Containing Two hundred and Eight Acres and 142 perches and the Allowance of Six Per Cent for Roads &c. Surveyed the 23^d day of June 1804, agreeable to the lines of the adjacent Surveys In pursuance of a Warrant Granted to James Kennedy dated the 4th day of June 1762.

N.B. The above mentioned Warrant appears to have been formerly Executed for James Kennedy agreeable to the dotted line thro the Survey of James Waddle bearing S 33 E from the Hick^l Corner at the foot of a high Hill to a W.O. Cor. of Wm Beale & In^o Sherrard.
