Granted to Conrad Snider\* for 100<sup>o</sup> dated the 23<sup>o</sup> day of February A.D. 1767, and N<sup>o</sup> 4447 Granted to Michael Kessler for 50<sup>o</sup> dated the 3<sup>o</sup> day of October A.D. 1767. Said to be Improved about 13 years. And now at the request of the Present owner Michael Kessler I am desired to make return of the Draught as Calculated Examined & the 8<sup>th</sup> day of July Anno Domini 1809.
