Resurveyed and a piece of vacancy added by William Kersey late D.S. on the 12<sup>th</sup> of the 4<sup>th</sup> Mo<sup>r</sup> 1792. And now at the request of the present owner George Keener I am desired to make Return of the Draught as Calculated Examined and corrected the 19<sup>th</sup> day of August 1809.
