



Draft of a part of two tracts of Land situate in Windham township Luzerne County formally Northumberland County containing viz: Michael Withers One hundred eighteen acres Eighty two perches, John Miller of Strasburg thirty acres two perches, and allowance of six per ct. &c. and containing in the whole One hundred forty eight acres Eighty four perches and allowance of six per ct. &c.

Said two tracts of Land was Surveyed the sixth day of October A. D. 1773 on two separate warrants dated the third day of April A. D. 1769 respectively granted to Michael Withers and John Miller of Strasburg, and Resurveyed at the request of Paul B. Jennings by Zebulon H. Stevens late Deputy Surveyor the Ninth day of December A. D. 1837 and Certified by me this sixteenth day of March A. D. 1841.
