



By virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietor Dated the 15<sup>th</sup> Day of October Anno Domini 1736 The above Described Tract of Land was Surveyed unto Evan Lloyd — On Coccoosing Creek in the County of Lancaster Beginning at a White Oak in a line of the Land now of Thomas Lloyd Thence North 33 Degrees East by Vacant Land 160 Pches to a Small Black Oak Thence South 57 Degrees East by Vacant Land 123 perches to a White Oak Thence South 33 Degrees West by Vacant Land 160 Pches to a Small White Oak — Thence North 57 Degrees West by y<sup>e</sup> land of Thomas Lloyd 123 perches to y<sup>e</sup> place of Beginning Containing One Hundred and sixteen acres beside y<sup>e</sup> allowance of six  $\frac{1}{2}$  Cent for Roads.
