



By virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the fifth day of June 1734 Surveyed unto Isaac Levant a Tract of Land Situate in Oley-in-ye County of Philad^a. Begining at a hickory a Corner of sd Levants other Land thence by vacant Land North West Ninety four perches to a Black Oak Sap^g in the line of Martin Pumpery's land thence by the same South West one hundred and Ten perches to a Hickery sapling thence by land of Nicholas Schang South Sixty Degrees East Ninety Seven perches to a post in the line of sd Isaac Levants Land thence by ye same North East Eighty five perches to ye place at Begining Containing fifty ^{four} ~~three~~ acres with the usual allowance of six ⁷/₈ Cent. Surveyed June 25. 1734
