 which is as large as ye neighbouring settle^{ts} woud
 admit of his War^t (ob^d) for 400 a^s & Zach^y Butcher
 had formerly run out this Tract which Isaac was Dis-
 atisfy'd with but now on a second Survey & a great deal
 of pains taken to convince him that he cou'd not have
 more without manifest injustice to ye adjacent settlements
 he's satisfy'd I am S^t ye most hble. serv^t
 Land - 26 July 1742. *Tho. Cookson.*
