



By VIRTUE of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the Third day of July 1734 Surveyed unto John Limeback a Tract of Land Situate in Oley in the County of Philad^a Beginning at an Ash Tree a corner of his other land thence by the same South West one Hundred and forty Eight perches to a stone a corner of his other land thence by Vacant Land North West fifty seven perches and a half perch to a Black Oak thence by vacant land North East one hundred and forty Eight perches to a post in a line of James Hays Land thence by the same South East fifty seven perches and a half perch to y^e place of Beginning containing fifty acres with the usual allowance of Six $\frac{1}{2}$ Cent — Surveyed August 30th 1734.
